

Instructions to run Microsoft Visio 2010 in Windows 8 VM on Macbook

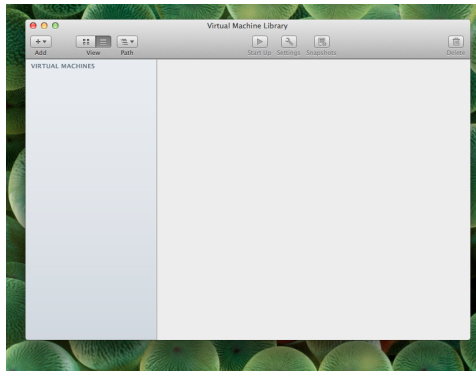
We need to download three softwares: **VMware Fusion**, **Windows 8 x64** and **Microsoft Visio 2010**. For the Data Management Course we will use Microsoft Visio 2010 and not the latest 2013 version.

Step 1: Download and Install VMware Fusion 6 (for Mac OS X) from vmap.usi.ch.

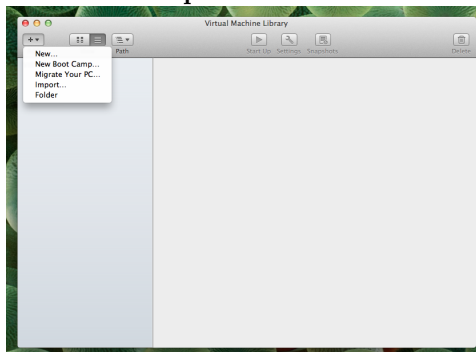
Step 2: Download the “Microsoft Windows 8 Professional 32/64-bit (English)- DreamSpark” from <http://msdnaa.usi.ch/index-en.htm>. Detailed steps to install Windows 8 follow can be found [here](#). Don't forget to note down the Windows Product Key!

Step 3: Open VMware Fusion and create a Virtual Machine to install Windows 8 Professional. The Detailed steps are shown below:

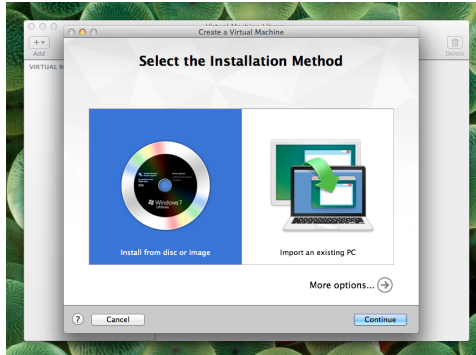
Step 3.1: Open VMWare Fusio and click on the “Add” button



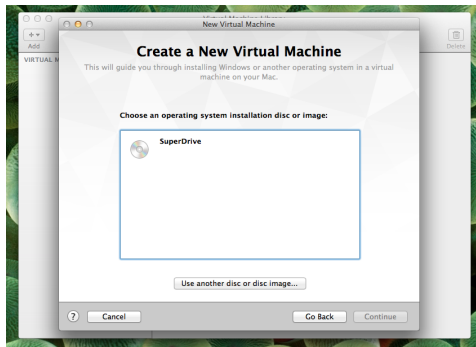
Step 3.2: Select the “New” option to create a new Virtual Machine



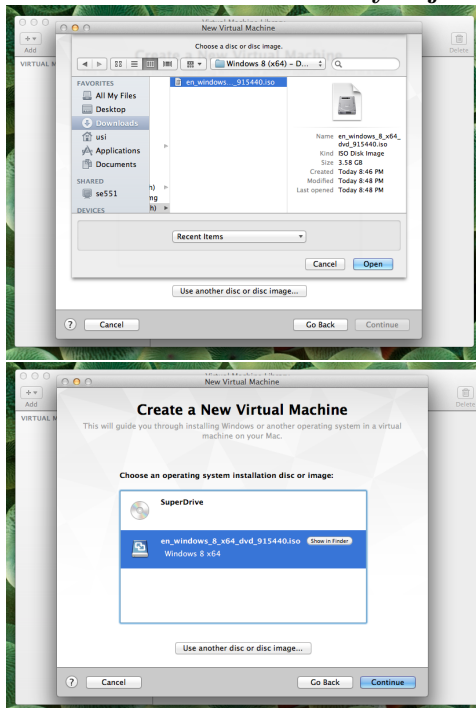
Step 3.3: Select “Install from disc or image”



Step 3.4: Select “Use another disc or disc image...”



Step 3.5: Select the Windows 8 iso file you just downloaded



Step 3.7: Enter your Windows Product Key and click continue



Step 4: Download Microsoft Visio 2010 from <http://msdnna.usi.ch/index-en.htm>. Don't forget to note down the Product Key!.

Step 5: Copy the Microsoft Visio 2010 (.iso) file into Windows 8 and install it.
