

Bedrooms at Monte Verità

Its splendid location with panoramic view over Lago Maggiore and the utter silence and beauty of this place make Monte Verità the ideal destination for your conference.

The Monte Verità hotel is a member of Swiss Historic Hotels.

The CSF reserves maximal 16 single rooms and 23 double rooms in the main building and the Villa Semiramis, plus the casa Monescia and the casa Gioia, depending on your specification in the application form.

Bauhaus hotel

The main building of the Monte Verità hotel complex is the Bauhaus Hotel. It was built between 1927 and 1929 by the architect Emil Fahrenkamp, commissioned by Baron Eduard von der Heydt, a German banker and art collector who was the penultimate owner of the hill. It includes the conference rooms, the restaurant and the hotel front desk. There are six single rooms and 16 double rooms. The rooms are equipped with free Wi-Fi connection, hairdryers and telephones. Televisions and air conditioning is not available.

- two pairs of rooms 201/202 and 301/302 have a shared bathroom - the rooms are separate and the bathroom entrance is independent
- the rooms 208 and 308 have a grand-lit; they can also be used as double rooms
- the rooms 201 to 208 and 301 to 308 have a balcony and a breath-taking view over the lake and the surrounding mountains



Villa Semiramis



Villa Semiramis was built in Art Nouveau style in 1909 by the Turin-born architect Anselmo Secondo and is situated adjacent to the green tea plantation. There are ten single rooms and ten double rooms. The rooms are equipped with free Wi-Fi connection, hairdryers and telephones. Televisions and air conditioning is not available.

- The rooms 136/137 have a shared bathroom - the rooms are separate and the bathroom entrance is independent
- Eight rooms have a balcony and most of the rooms have a breath-taking view over the lake and the surrounding mountains

Casa Monescia

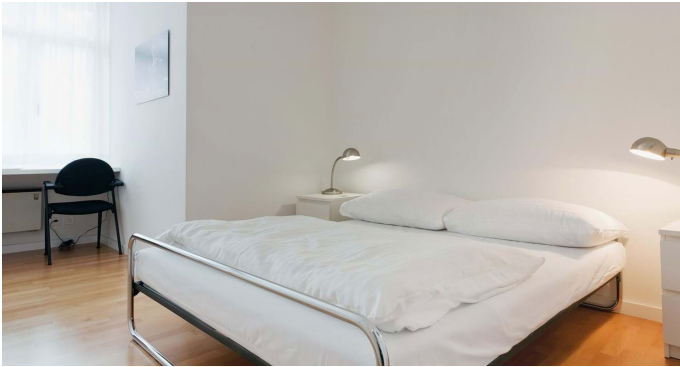
Casa Monescia is a beautiful house surrounded by the verdant parkland of Monte Verità. One wing of the house, which was later completely overhauled and modernised, was the home of the vegetarian colony's first secretary Alexander Wilhelm de Beauclair. It is suitable for students or for a participant who comes with family. The walk from this house to the Bauhaus building requires 2 - 3 minutes uphill and may therefore not be suitable for senior participants. Free wireless internet access is available in all rooms in this building.

The Casa Monescia features:

- 2 single rooms
- 1 double room with two beds
- 1 shared bathroom
- 1 additional shared toilet
- A kitchen, a living room and a terrace



Casa Gioia



Casa Gioia, is situated at the foot of the Monte Verità property. It is suitable for students or young participants. The walk from this house to the Bauhaus building requires max. 5 minutes uphill. Free wireless internet access available in all rooms in this building.

The Casa Gioia features 4 single rooms:

- room 505 with a grand-lit and private bathroom (suitable for couples)
- room 502 with a grand-lit, rooms 503 and 501 with single beds. These three rooms share one bathroom.
