... it takes about 30 seconds for a red blood cell to make a complete circuit of your body.

... in Japan it is thought your blood type is closely connected to your personality type. Individual with type A blood are generally mild-tempered and intellectual, while type B are the opposite. ... red blood cells live on average for about 120 days, they are constantly recycled by macrophages and produced by the bone marrow.

... after having a blood transfusion at the age of 13, James Harrison pledged to give blood once he turned 18. He stuck to his word and it was discovered that his blood contained a rare antigen. He has donated blood over 1'000 times and as a result has contributed to save 2 millions lives.

Did you know?

... a single drop of blood contains about 10'000 white blood cells and 250'000 platelets. ... while there are 8 common blood types, with only four of those being major – A, B, AB and 0 – there are actually 35 different recognized blood group systems. Cows, meanwhile, have 800 different blood types.

... a newborn baby has around just one cup of blood in its body. The average human adult has around 5 liters, about 7% of our total body weight. ... human blood is never actually blue: our veins appear blue through our skin because of the way the light penetrates, is absorbed and reflects back to our eyes.
